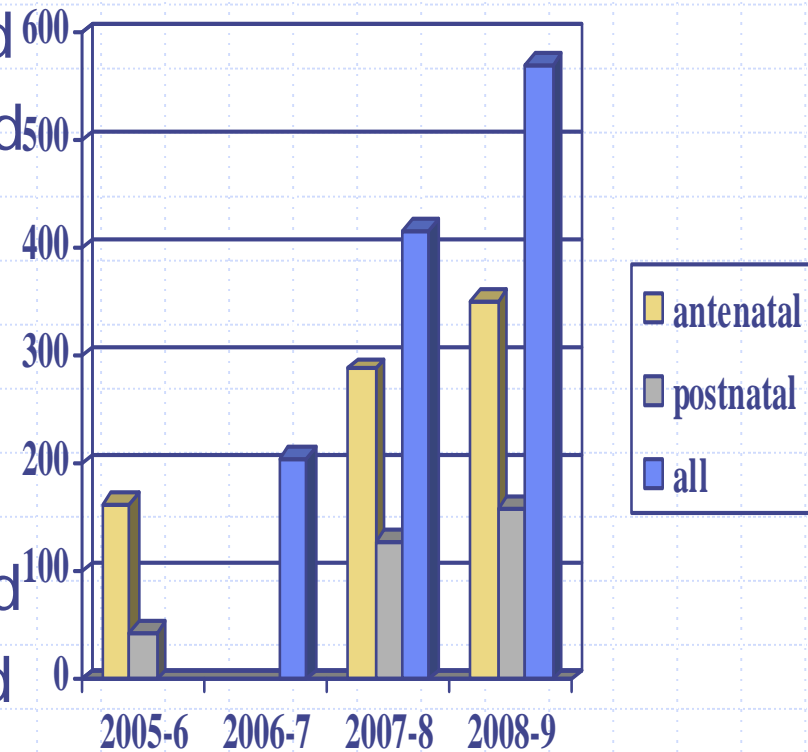

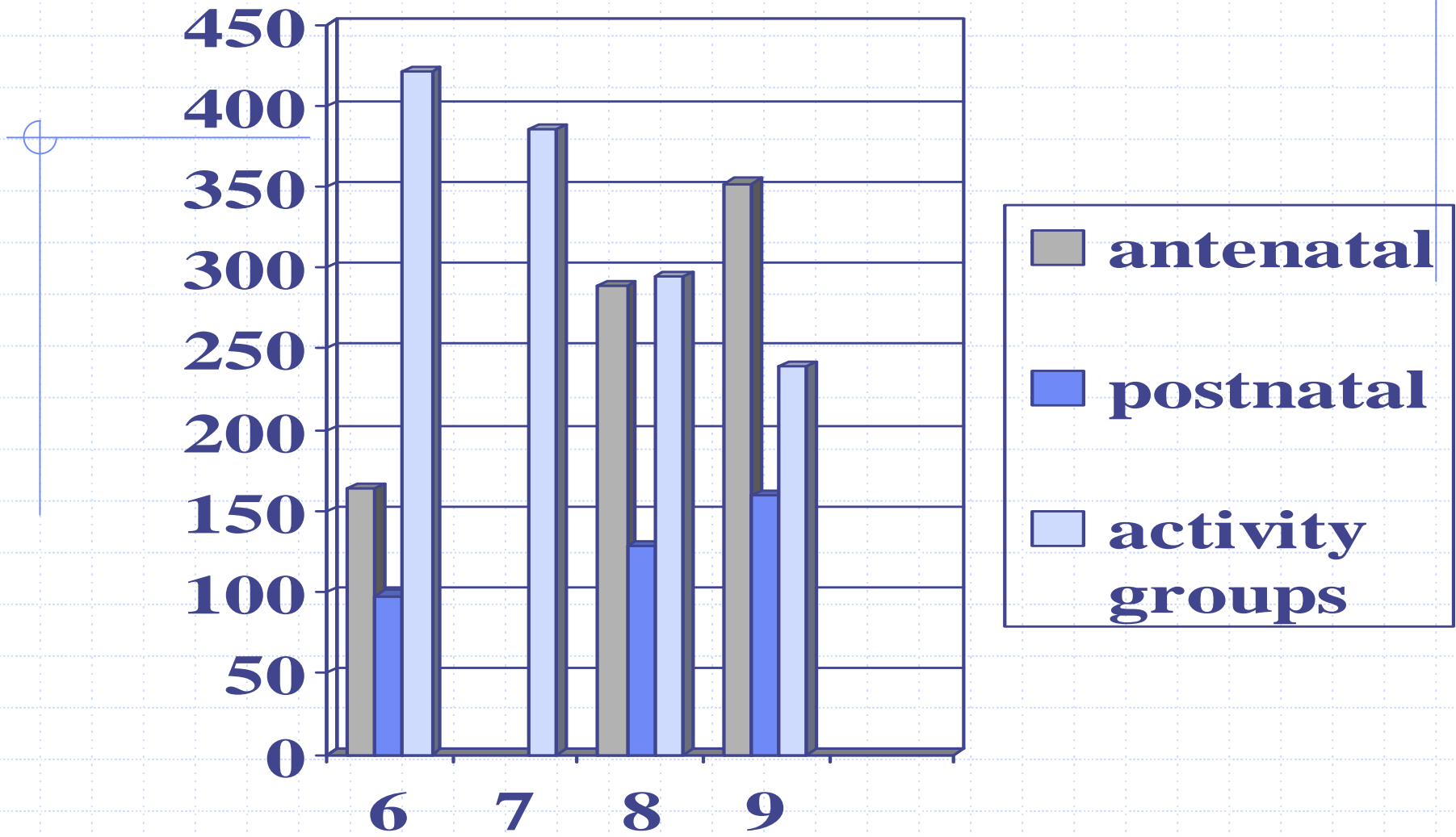

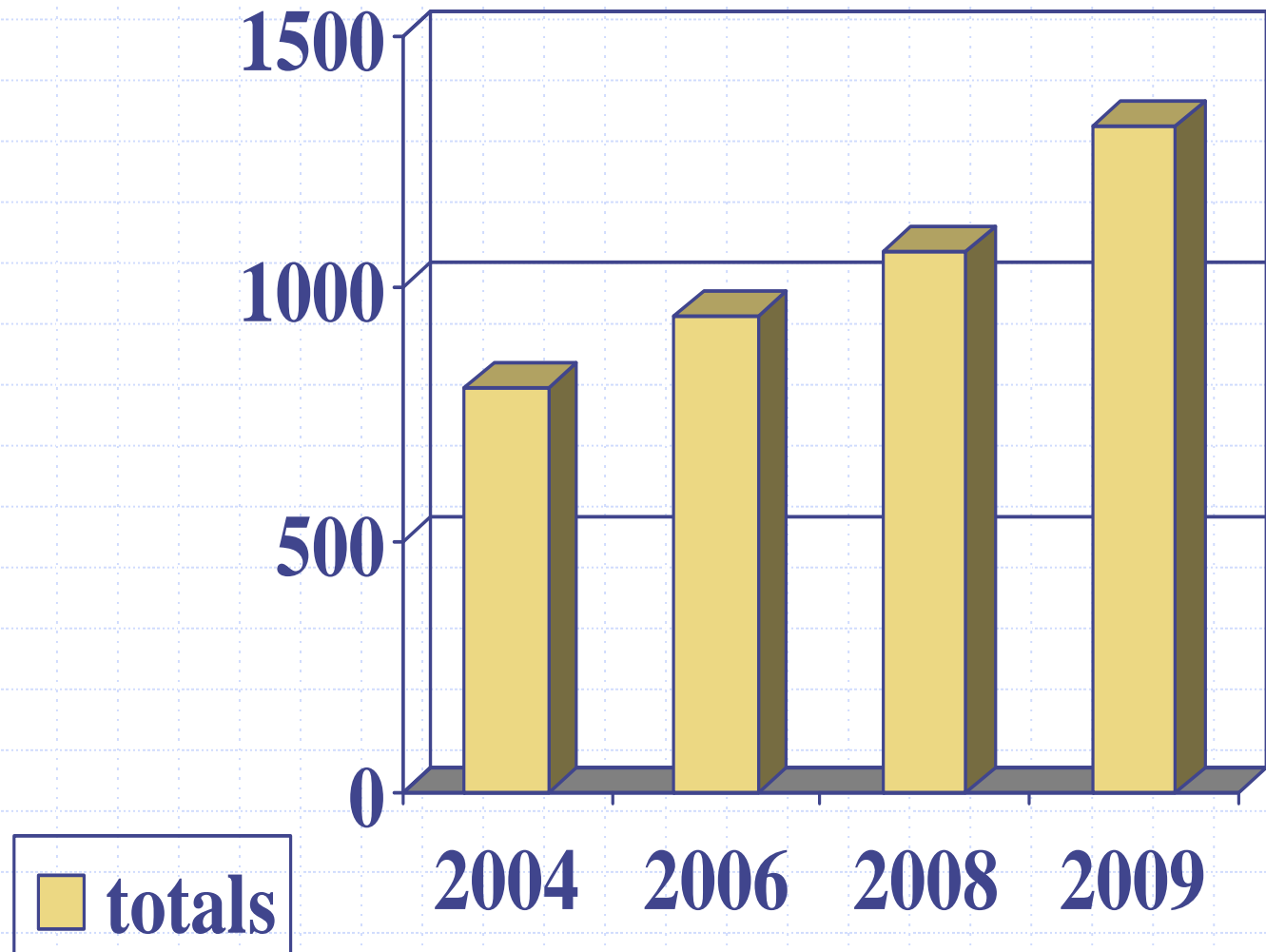




Other services
